



Procedures for CE Activity Participation

1. Register for the CE activity on Acurity's CE website: <https://ce.pharmacy.acurity.com>. If you have not set up an account before, you need to set it up before registration. Your NABP e-PID and birth date are required to set up an account on the CE website. Note: If participating as a group, each person **must** register on the CE website prior to participation.
2. Once you have registered for the CE activity, scroll down the program's page and click on the link to register on GoToWebinar (GTW) (if participating as a group, only one person needs to register on GTW):
